 Established 1973 — our building was constructed in 1979 and can seat 150 people.


 Situated at 2 Helen Street on 20 rolling and forested acres at the north end of Cornwall.

AUTHORITY & GOVERNANCE

- › Supervisory authority over church staff (hiring/removal requires Elder Board approval).
- › May attend all committees and boards as Ex-Officio Member.
- › Helps formulate and recommend Policy Statements with the Elders.

- › Spend time daily in God's Word and in prayer.
- › Encourage congregational participation in church ministries.
- › Attend and contribute to Staff, Elder, and Deacon meetings.
